NOTICE TO MARINA FACILITY USERS

COVID-19 / CORONAVIRUS: MEASURES & GUIDLINES

 ${\it IMPORTANT}$: FRENCH GOVERNMENT HAS DECREED UPDATED GENERAL MEASURES (DECREE N° 2020-1262 OF OCTOBER 16th, 2020) APPLICABLE DURING THE SANITARY STATE OF EMERGENCY NEWLY RE-DECLARED ON OCTOBER 14TH, 2020. SPECIFIC MEASURES ARE IMPLEMENTED FOR SAINT-MARTIN BY PREFECTORAL DECREE.

In compliance with the various measures to combat the spread of the COVID-19 virus imposed by French Government, the following rules & guidelines apply at MARINA FORT LOUIS until further notice:

1/ Access to Marina office is open to the public since June 2ND 2020 :

- Open Monday to Friday, 8 am to 12 pm / 2 pm to 5 pm. Weekends & Holidays, 8 am to 12 pm
- Masks are mandatory when visiting Marina offices
- 2 persons max. allowed into office spaces at a time

2/ Guests are encouraged to conduct business & access Marina services by Email (info@marinafortlouis.com), Telephone (05.90.77.31.26), VHF (Ch. 16) & use of Online services via Marina website (www.marinafortlouis.com). Reminder of the Security hotline in case of emergency after business hours - Cell. 06.90.20.12.02.

3 / Access to the port area is subject to compliance with specific sanitary precautionary rules:

- respect hygiene measures known as "barrier gestures" under all circumstances and maintain a 3ft safety distance from others
- wear a mask, it is mandatory in port terminals, public waiting areas, as well as all situations where physical distance is not guaranteed
- do not gather in groups (public gatherings are limited to max. 6 persons)

4/ All facility users are required to sign a IN / OUT form at Security checkpoint when accessing the port area.

Visitor access to Marina remains restricted. Captains must inform Marina office ahead when expecting a visitor. **Vendors and Service providers** must request temporary access with min. 48 hours advance notice – a COVID-19 prevention form will be completed by the business owner or management.

5/ During cleaning & disinfection, access to **restrooms** is closed to guests for a maximum duration of 1 hour.

6/ Marigot Port **Clearance** service assistance (entry/exit) is ensured digitally exclusively. Users must complete their request online (http://clairance.portdemarigot.com), then send Clearance Number by email for processing and visa with copy of vessels registry & valid ID of all persons on board.

7/ Fuel and Water supply available by appointment only - proceed to online reservation via Marina website: persons on board vessels are strictly forbidden to disembark from vessel during operations.

8/ TEMPORARILY UNAVAILABLE SERVICES : Ice ; Anguilla Clearance ; Onsite Clearance Assistance ; "ENTRY" Clearance for vessels <u>prohibited entry by sea</u> to Saint-Martin as per rules & travel restrictions in effect.

Marina office will be sure to keep you informed of additional measures according to updates by Government authorities. **Be responsible & Be safe!**
