Captain or Agent must provide Galisbay Port Authority with vessels OUTBOUND clearance certificate from last port of call. QUARANTINE / DENIAL OF ENTRY In absence of outbound clearance confirming origin of vessel, the Port Authority may : Impose a quarantine on vessel up to 14 days ; Deny entry to port area and maritime domain. Quarantined vessels will anchor in Marigot Bay. Vessels will fly the 'L' (Lima) flag or 'Q' (Quebec) flag, visible on all horizons, until they have satisfied quarantine requirements. |
