SAINT-BARTHÉLÉMY GUADELOUPE MARTINIQUE GUYANE	<p>PRIOR TO ARRIVAL</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All persons aboard must be in possession of a sworn declaration of no symptoms of Covid-19 and no contact with a confirmed case of Covid-19 within 14 days prior to voyage. - Captain or Agent must provide Galisbay Port Authority with vessels OUTBOUND clearance certificate from last port of call. <p>QUARANTINE / DENIAL OF ENTRY In absence of outbound clearance confirming origin of vessel, the Port Authority may :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Impose a quarantine on vessel up to 14 days ; - Deny entry to port area and maritime domain. <p>Quarantined vessels will anchor in Marigot Bay.</p> <p>Vessels will fly the 'L' (Lima) flag or 'Q' (Quebec) flag, visible on all horizons, until they have satisfied quarantine requirements.</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL OTHER COUNTRIES (including Sint-Maarten, Anguilla, rest of Caribbean countries & USA)</p> <p style="text-align: center;">SUCH VESSELS <u>MAY APPLY FOR SPECIAL ENTRY APPROVAL</u> <u>WITH FRENCH AUTHORITIES</u> <i>based on essential travel reasons or transit exceptions</i></p>	<p>PRIOR TO ARRIVAL</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All persons aboard must be in possession of a sworn declaration of no symptoms of Covid-19 and no contact with a confirmed case of Covid-19 within 14 days prior to voyage. - Captain or Agent must apply for special entry approval via email to French MRCC minimum 24 H prior to arrival, including : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Ship entry application form. o Negative « RT-PCR COVID » test for each person aboard, carried out within 72 H prior to vessels departure from last port of call. <p>Contact : fortdefrance.mrcc@developpement-durable.gouv.fr Ph. +596.596.70.92.92 – VHF 16</p> <p>Captain or Agent will provide the Port Authority with copy of vessels authorization and all above mentioned documents.</p> <p>QUARANTINE Authorization delivered by Maritime Affairs dept. may impose a quarantine on vessel up to 14 days.</p>

In all cases, the usual customs & immigration rules apply (clearance, visas, duration of stay, etc.).
