END OF HURRICANE WARNING - RESUMPTION OF ACTIVITIES

Resumption of marina activities

Start : 22/10/2023 at 8 am End : -

All facility users at MARINA FORT LOUIS are hereby kindly informed of the following update:

Marina Fort Louis is once again open to the public as of SUNDAY, October 22, 2023, at 08:00 AM, following the lifting of the hurricane warning by local authorities. At this stage, Hurricane TAMMY no longer poses a threat to St. Martin and St. Barths. However, caution is still advised as several alerts are in effect until Monday, 10/23/2023, in the evening, for risk of heavy rain, thunderstorms, hazardous surf, and strong winds.

A return to normalcy is organized under the following conditions, starting this Sunday:

- Boaters can return to their vessels at the marina from 09:00 AM.
- Watercraft movements are once again allowed on the water while exercising extreme caution.
- Dock attendance will be available from 09:00 AM to 12:00 PM.
- The Marina Office is closed, and will reopen from Monday, 10/23/2023, at 08:00 AM.
- Water and electricity will be fully restored on-site by Monday morning at the latest.
- Other ancillary services, such as fuel distribution and gated parking, will be reinstated progressively, as weather conditions subside.

SPECIAL MEASURES & GUIDELINES

CAUTION: We would like to remind you of the safety instructions to follow after a hurricane alert has been lifted. The marina will undergo a comprehensive assessment of equipment and networks (electricity/water). We will keep you informed of any additional information regarding the resumption of services.

For your safety, it is recommended to consider all electrical circuits and devices as LIVE at all times. Do not touch or attempt to tamper with electrical lines or equipment of any kind after a weather event.
